

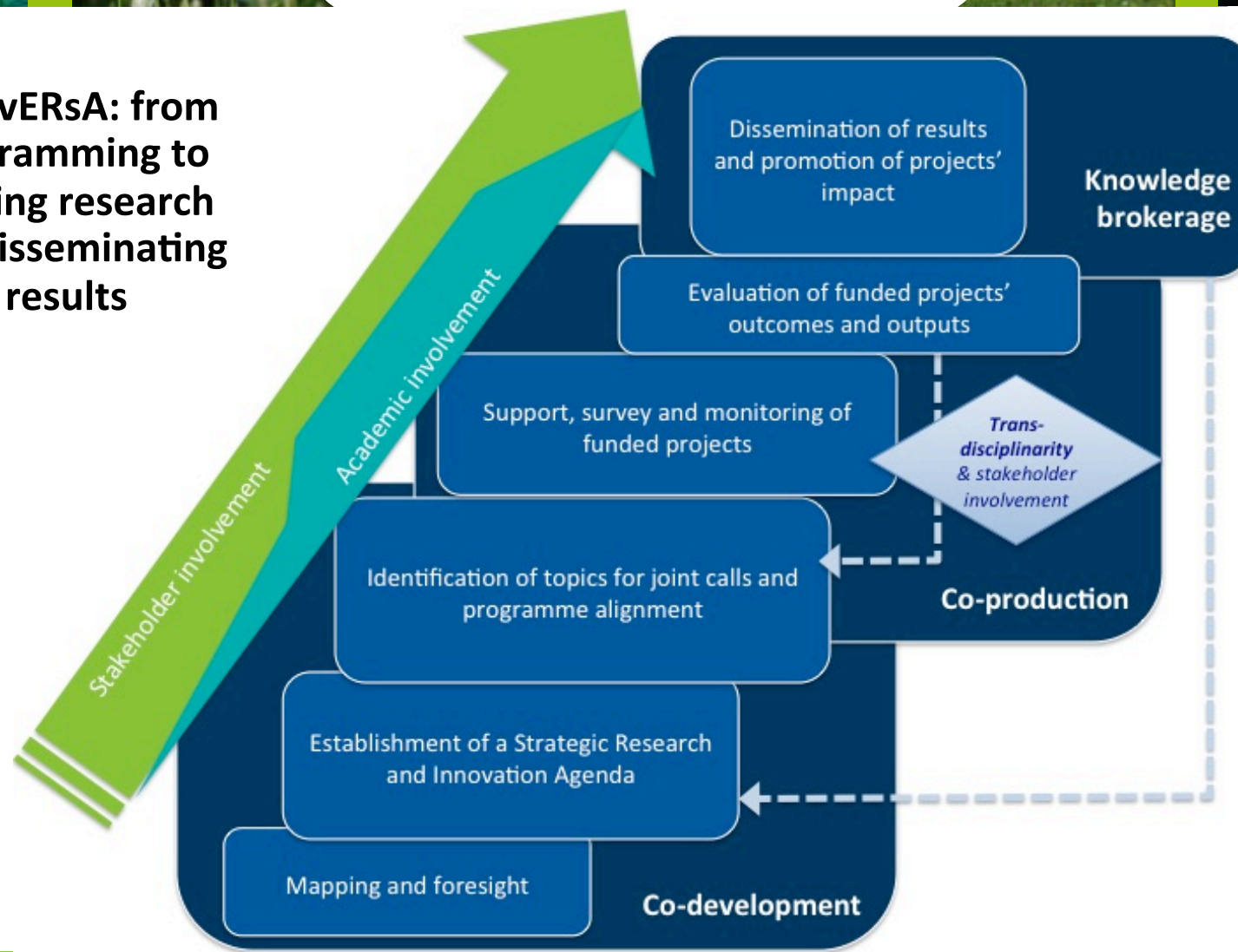

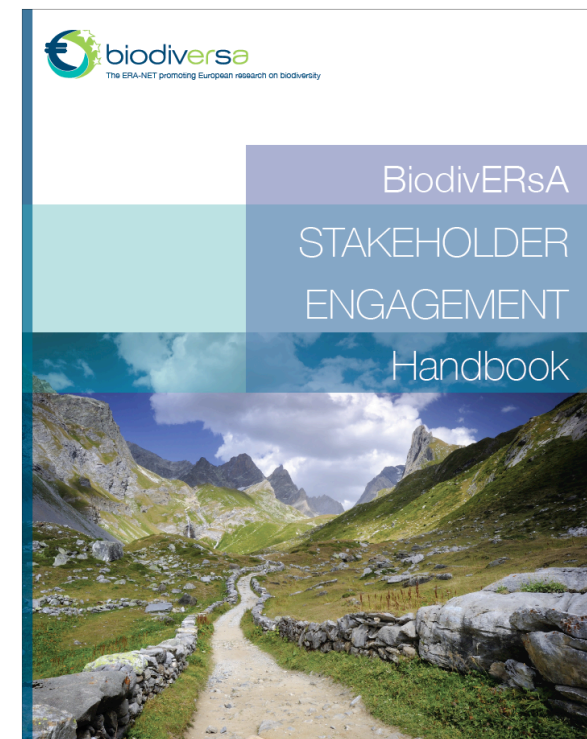


## Involving stakeholders

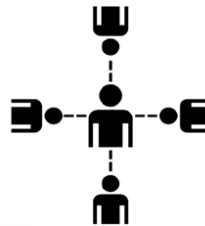

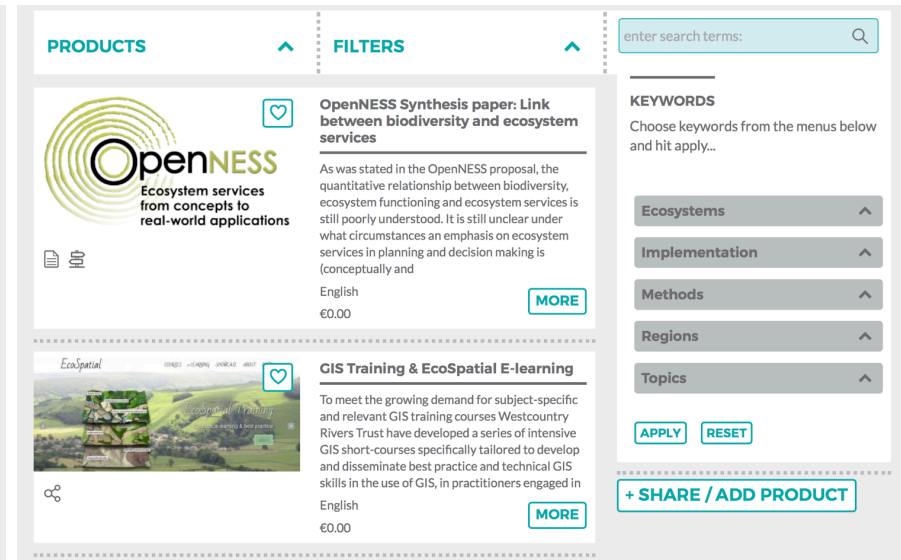
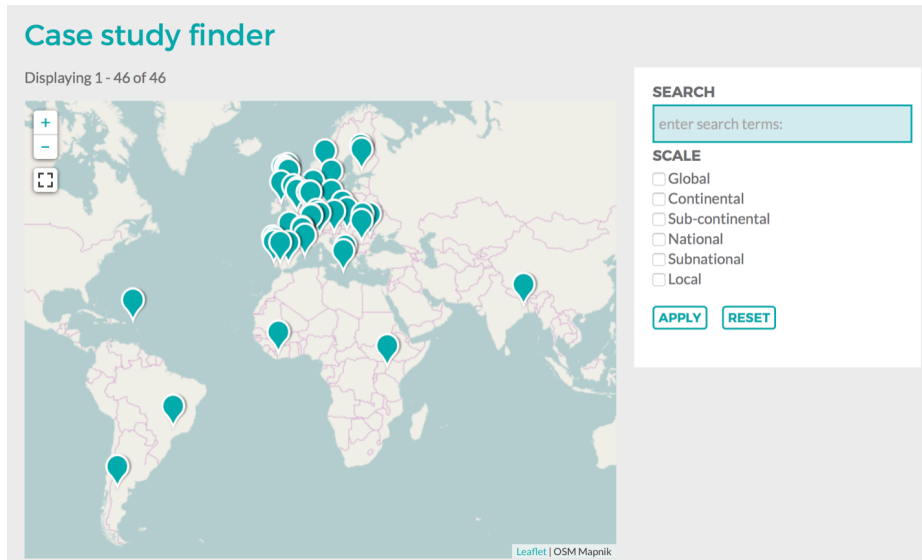
