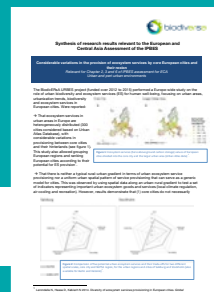
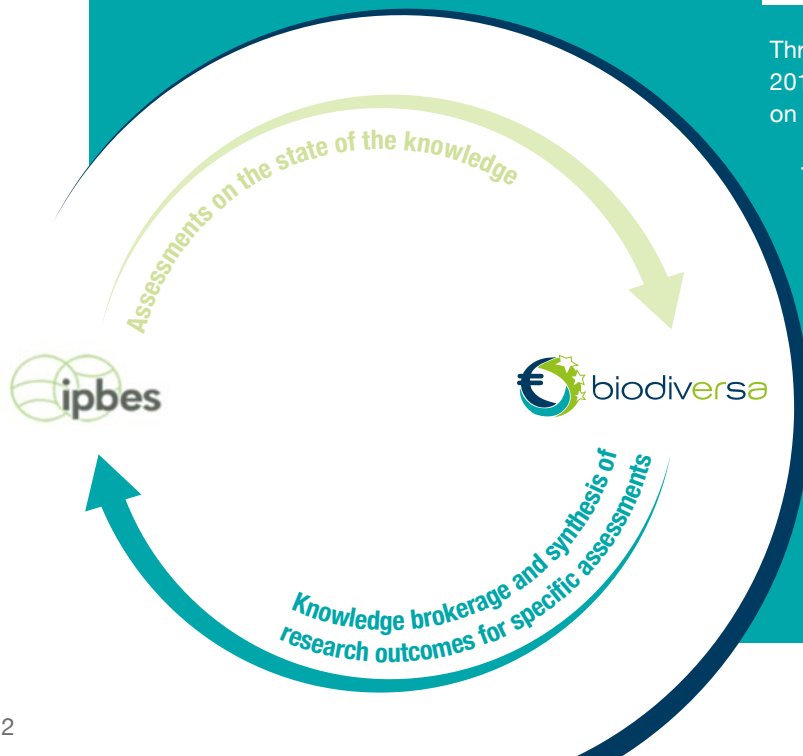
TO FEED IPBES ASSESSMENTS OF BIODIVERSITY STATUS AND ISSUES

SUCCESS STORY

Throughout the Europe and Central Asia assessment (2016-2018), BiodivERsA provided authors with factsheets based on results from its funded projects. As a result:

- **Results from 9 BiodivERsA projects** actually fed the assessment, with **at least 11 references**;
- **1 success story** is directly traceable to a fact-sheet provided by BiodivERsA;
- This approach was cited as exemplary by the IPBES assessment's Technical Support Unit.

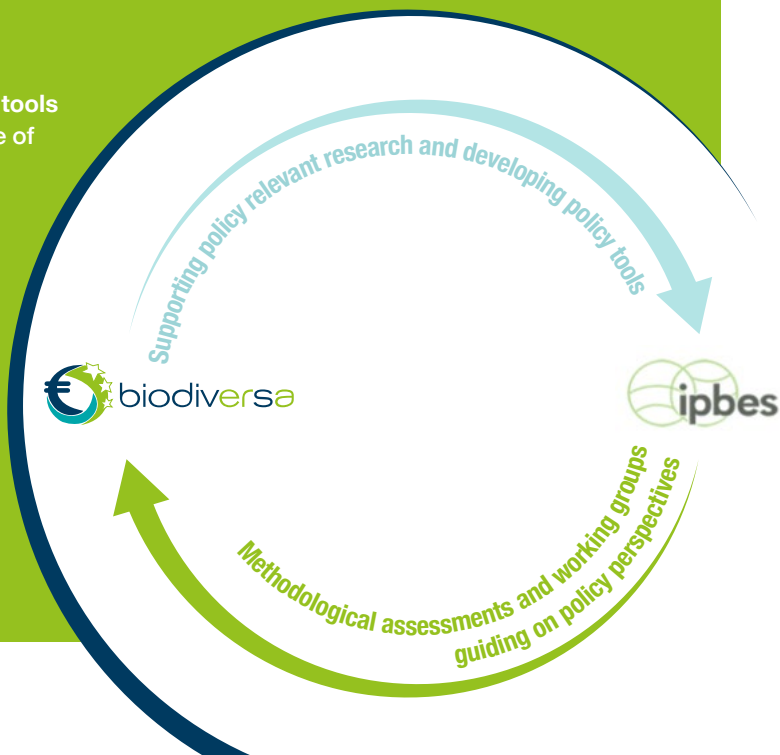
ONGOING DEVELOPMENTS

STIMULATING KNOWLEDGE GENERATION

TO FILL MAJOR KNOWLEDGE GAPS

 BiodivERsA is now co-hosting the IPBES Technical Support Unit on Knowledge and Data for the generation of new knowledge.

SUCCESS STORY

BiodivERsA helped address knowledge gaps identified in the IPBES assessment on biodiversity scenarios, by:

- implementing a research programme building on IPBES-identified gaps, with the Belmont Forum in 2017;
- this programme mobilized **26 funding agencies** from **23 countries** (EU & non- EU) for a total of **28 million €** in cash.

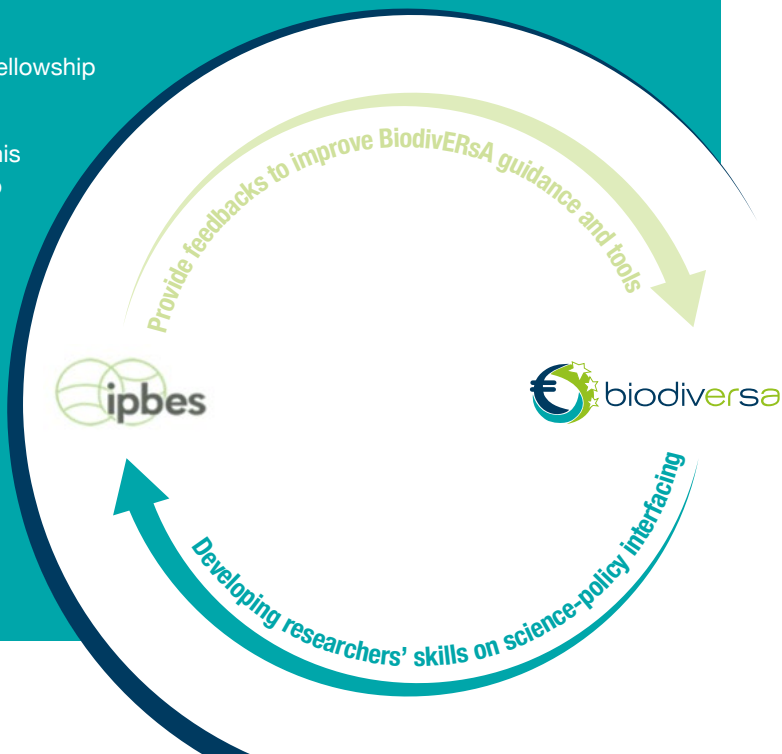
SUCCESS STORY
