I have conducted a citizen science project on my own on the invasive Spanish Slug in Austria (https://shortly.cc/cVkt). Through my experience in the coordination of Austrias biggest national citizen science platform and in conducting my own citizen science project I have expertise in the development of large networks and the advantages and pitfalls when using citizen science as a method. I did a postgraduate course on open innovation in science and therefore also can offer insights in this approach.
